From the Parish history archives...
1902. "One of the accomplishments of Father Joseph Tiernan after obtaining the rectory and paying off the mortgage was to obtain bells. To his mind, "A church is not a church unless it had bells." "They are some of the finest church bells in the area"... and are named:
Joseph - "Justitia et pax" (Justice & Peace)
Mary - "Ave Maria, Gratia Plena" (Hail Mary, Full of Grace)
John Louis - "We proclaim the Unity of Faith and the Golden Jubilee" September 7th, 1902."
